**Directions to Rockland Place, 1519 Rockland Road, Wilmington, DE 19803:**

**From the North:** Take 202 South and make a right at Murphy Road. (AstraZeneca headquarters is on the corner.) Stay in the middle lane and at the next light cross over Route 141 and make a really quick right into the entrance of the Rockland Place complex. NARFE meets in the Brandywine Room in the main building down the hallway to the left of the main desk.

**From the South:** Take 202 North to the exit for 141 South; this becomes Powder Mill Road. Take this to Childrenø Drive and turn left at the light and then a quick right into the entrance of Rockland Place complex. NARFE meets in the main building in the Brandywine Room down the hallway to the left of the main desk.

**An alternative from the South** is taking 141 North past DuPontø Experimental Station, etc. Make a right when you see the sign for the A. I. DuPont Childrenø Hospital at Childrenø Drive and then a really quick right into the entrance of the Rockland Place complex.
